

FCC COVID-19 Safety Measures

Throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, Faith Community Church has always made the safety of our congregation and those utilizing our building a top priority. As the Massachusetts Governor's orders change, we continue to make adjustments to our safety measures. Here is a list of what we are currently doing at Faith Community Church

- Masks are required at all times while on church property with the exception of those with a medical condition, actively leading worship, or children under 5years old.
- Hand sanitizing stations are located throughout the building.
- Professional sanitation before and between worship services.
- Every other pew is blocked off to allow for social distancing.
- Pews are limited to 6 people at one time.
- Windows are open and fans are on to allow for better ventilation.
- Hymnals, bibles and all shared items have been removed.
- Individual, one time use Communion is provided.
- A digital bulletin has replaced paper bulletins.
- New air purifiers are in all rooms that house children's programs.
- K-12 Sunday school has made seating adjustments to allow for social distancing.
- K-12 activities no longer share supplies for crafts or activities. Each student is provided with their own supplies to use each class.
- The building is professionally cleaned multiple times per week.
- The church no longer provides communal food or drink on-site for fellowship times.
- Zoom meetings and small groups
- Weekly online Sunday worship services and online special services are broadcast via Facebook and Youtube.
- Meetings and FaithGroups are available via Zoom.
